



**Andrew Pitt and Johnny Aubert World Champions !

After Breugelmans MX3 world title and Teillet MX2 European Championship, Premier gained another world championship victory with Andrew Pitt in World Supersport! In Magny Cours Andrew won the race showing strong determination and obtaining his second World Supersport Championship (he has won the first one in 2001).

In the same Supersport Magny Cours race, a good sixth place for Gianluca Nannelli while Massimo Roccoli arrived very close to Nannelli in seventh position.

Fourteenth place for Ivan Clementi and seventeenth for David Salom.

Very good performances for Premier young GP125 riders in the last four races of the world championship. Nico Terol obtained a fantastic second place in his Valencia home race, ending the championship in fifth position. In Motegi Japan race Terol was fifth and ninth in Malaysia GP.

I'm very happy – he said after the race -Second place at home in the last race of the year is fantastic. Mike and Simone had great pace, and I had a little collision with Simone that ran me into the grass and meant that I lost a little rhythm. I'm happy with all the work that the team have done, It was a great battle and a step forward for me this season.

Pol Espargarò obtained the fifth place in Australia and the sixth position in Malaysian Sepang race. Fifteenth years old Spanish Marc Marquez reached the ninth place in Phillips Island race in Australia but due to an accident during Sepang race he was forced to end his racing season. Alexis Masbou and his new Loncin Chinese bike obtained some points in Japan and Valencia races.

Great result for French Johnny Aubert, who showed to be one of the strongest rider of the world. Aubert closed the World Championship in the last day, surrounded by a numerous public. The 16 points of advantage on the rival gave to Aubert a relative calm: he was be able to fight for the victory in the two race days, conquering the best times in more occasions. Johnny known how to have self-control in the most insidious situations. He closed second on Saturday, and third on Sundays winning E2 Enduro world Championship. Concerning the other riders of the UFO Team, the best was Simone Albergoni, fourth and fifth while Maurizio Micheluz has to face many falls, but he was satisfied of two seventh positions. Fabrizio Dini collected a ninth place on Saturday and an eighth one on Sunday.
