



FIRST PODIUM FOR MARQUEZ AND THIRD WIN FOR ANDREW PITT

First podium for young Spanish rider Marc Marquez in Donington GP 125 race.

‘I feel very happy – Repsol KTM rookie said after the race - my first podium in my first season and I can’t ask for anything more. I dedicate this to my team and my sponsors. It was a hard race and the wind made things difficult, but I’m on the podium and I’m delighted with that.’

Unfortunately Marquez is the only happy Premier rider in Donington because Pol Espargaro fractured his collarbone in a free practice crash on Saturday morning and the 17 year-old ruled out for the rest of the British Grand Prix.

Espargaro : ‘I’ve broken the same bone I broke two years ago and it is a real shame because we have been doing quite well in the Championship recently,’ he continued. ‘Now I’m going to miss one or two races, but I hope to get well as quickly as possible and get back to scoring points as soon as I can.’

Unlucky race for Nico Terol that arrived only in eighteenth position and for Alexis Masbou that reached the twenty eight position.

Nico Terol is now fourth in championship standing, while Pol Espargaro is fifth.

PITT : ANOTHER VICTORY !

Another great victory for Andrew Pitt that's now leading Supersport championship standing. In Nurburgring the Supersport race was red flagged because of a big crash at the first curve of the first lap. In the second race, Pitt started very quickly from his pole position and after a long struggle, his opponents yielded and Andrew reached his third victory of the year. Gianluca Nannelli was involved in the first curve crash. He restarted with his second spare bike but had to re-enter the box because of some technical problems thus ending the race. Massimo Roccoli crashed in middle of the race without physical consequences. Ivan Clementi also re-enter the box because of technical problems on his Triumph motorbike.

In Superbike a first good race for Spanish rider Ruben Xaus who obtained an important sixth position with his Ducati. Seventeenth position for Ayrton Badovini and twentieth for his teammate Vittorio Iannuzzo. Loic Napoleone retired because of some engine problem on his Yamaha. In second race Ruben Xaus reached the eighteenth final position and he's now in seventh place in Superbike championship standing. Napoleone arrived in twenty second position and an amazing accident happened between Iannuzzo and Badovini when Iannuzzo bike have hit the front wheel of Badovini bike. Both riders crashed and they cannot re-start the race because of some damages on their bikes.
