SUPERBIKE - In last four Superbike and Supersport races alternate results for Premier riders. Ruben Xaus is now tenth in Superbike world championship. No points for him in Brno and Brands Hatch due to health problem and some crashes. In Donington and Vallelunga he arrived eight and twelfth. Few points also for Kawasaki Pedercini riders Iannuzzo and Badovini.

SUPERSPORT - Andrew Pitt reached three podium : second place in Brno, third place in Brands Hatch and second place in Donington. Unfortunately he crashed in Vallelunga last race but he's still in first position in Supersport world championship standings at only two races from the end of the season. Good performances for Gianluca Nannelli while Roccoli, Clementi and Salom collected few points because of some technical problems on their bikes. New entry in Supersport for Scambia who replaced McCoy in Triumph official team both in Brno and Brands Hatch races.

SUPERSTOCK 1000 FIM CUP

Two sixth places for Michele Pirro in Brno and Brands Hatch. The young Italian rider reached only the nineteenth position in Donington after a crash. His team mate Magnoni was tenth in Brno, twenty first in Brands Hatch and crashed in Donington. Pirro is now fifth in Superstock 100 FIM Cup standings.

Excellent result for our riders in 125 GP races. In Brno Nico Terol obtained the fifth places while Pol Espargarò arrived in eight position. In Misano race young Spanish Marc Marquez was very close to the podium, ending in fourth position. Terol obtained the fifth place. Two Premier riders in Indianapolis! Terol won the race and Espargarò rached the second place.

Nico Terol – Race Winner : ‘I’m extremely happy! It was a strange weekend with the dry and wet conditions, and during the warmup this morning we had some problems which appeared to have been solved in the race. I was able to escape a little after catching Pol, but it was hard to know the limits once the rain had started to fall. This is a great win for me, and I want to thank everyone on the team and the sponsors for this.’

Pol Espargaro – Second Placed

‘I’m happy, second is not something that you get every weekend. In the wet I was 18th, so it isn’t so bad I suppose. I was a little uncertain about if the race would be wet or not. It was hard out there, because I escaped and made two seconds up but I couldn’t keep up that pace, my front end went at the end of the straight and Nico caught me. But we had a good weekend overall.’

Sven Breugelmans MX3 World Champion !

In the the last GP MX3 event out of a series of 16 at the German hard track of Jauer, Sven fairly easy managed to set pole during Saturday's qualifying session. After a reasonable start, Sven cruised the track in safety-mode and finished 7th. This result was all Sven needed to secure the 2008 MX3 World Championship title for KTM-JMRacing! Alvaro Lozano, despite a big accident during the season, reached the fifth position in MX3 final championship standing. In the EU-MX2 series it was JMRacing's European Champion Valentin Teillet who took care of business by (again) scoring an impressive double win. Valentin has been dominating the whole of the 2008 EU MX2 series and probably some EU riders do not mind to see him move on to the MX2 Grand Prix series in 2009.
